

Key Features

Producers must be certified according to two certifications: environmental and social. *Environmental certification: carried out by the Milieu Programma Sierteelt at MPS-A or by other comparable standards. MPS is an international organization that develops and controls labels for the horticultural industry. *Social certification: companies need to meet the requirements of FFP's International Code of Conduct. Producers with either one of the required certifications can participate conditionally in Fair Flowers Fair Plants having committed themselves to obtain the missing certification within 1 year. Producers with both the environmental and the social certification are fully accepted FFP participants. Traceability of products is mandatory. Fair Flowers Fair Plants products are sold through affiliated FFP traders and retailers. All the links within the chain must satisfy the requirements of Fair Flowers Fair Plants and are monitored to make sure they continue to do so.





Overall Breakdown






Proportion of indicators per sustainability areas, as referenced in the T4SD database.


Number of indicators per sustainability areas, as referenced in the T4SD database.





Experience from ITC-Swisscontact project:

Basic Guidelines for Sustainable Cocoa/ Lineamientos Básicos para un Cacao Sostenible (LBCS)

The LBCS project:

- ITC and Swisscontact initiated a programme to incorporate LBCS into the Standards Map online tool to [empower cocoa producers in Colombia](#) and [raise awareness around sustainability issues](#) required by certifications such as Fairtrade, UTZ and Rainforest Alliance
- ITC has developed an [off-line version of the LBCS tool](#), to enable farmers to [perform self-assessments](#) that allow them to get a first diagnostic report of areas which they need to improve before starting an official certification process

Launched: September 2015

Geographical scope: Colombia

Project results:

- By using the offline version of the LBCS tool, [26 farmer organizations](#) were trained and [500 cocoa farmers assessed](#) against the basic criteria for sustainable cocoa, with the goal to reach [1,000 farmers in 2016](#)
- The tool [creates greater awareness](#) of the LBCS and its benefits to cocoa farmers, increasing their access and competitiveness in international markets
